*Cathy Schoenberg: "Transition"*

Cathy Schoenberg, a painter for 35 years, lives in the Skagit Valley, 60 miles north of Seattle, on Guemes Island, a short ferry ride from Anacortes, where her studio is located.

The work in this exhibition indicates transition: from the figurative to the almost abstraction of flowers, both following a path of complex, vibrant color, patterns, rhythm and vibration.

"I started sketching with fervor 4 or 5 years ago, not as a precursor to painting, just for my own enrichment, like a daily practice, as in yoga! But Alas! That is exactly where it led me, to a new frontier: deep onto the texture, shapes, and lush wildness of flowers."

Schoenberg was born in Spokane, WA and obtained a BFA in fine art from Fort Wright College in 1975. Schoenberg's work has been shown in Skagit Valley area, Seattle, Bellingham, and San Juan Island since 1980.
