*Annual Student Art Show*

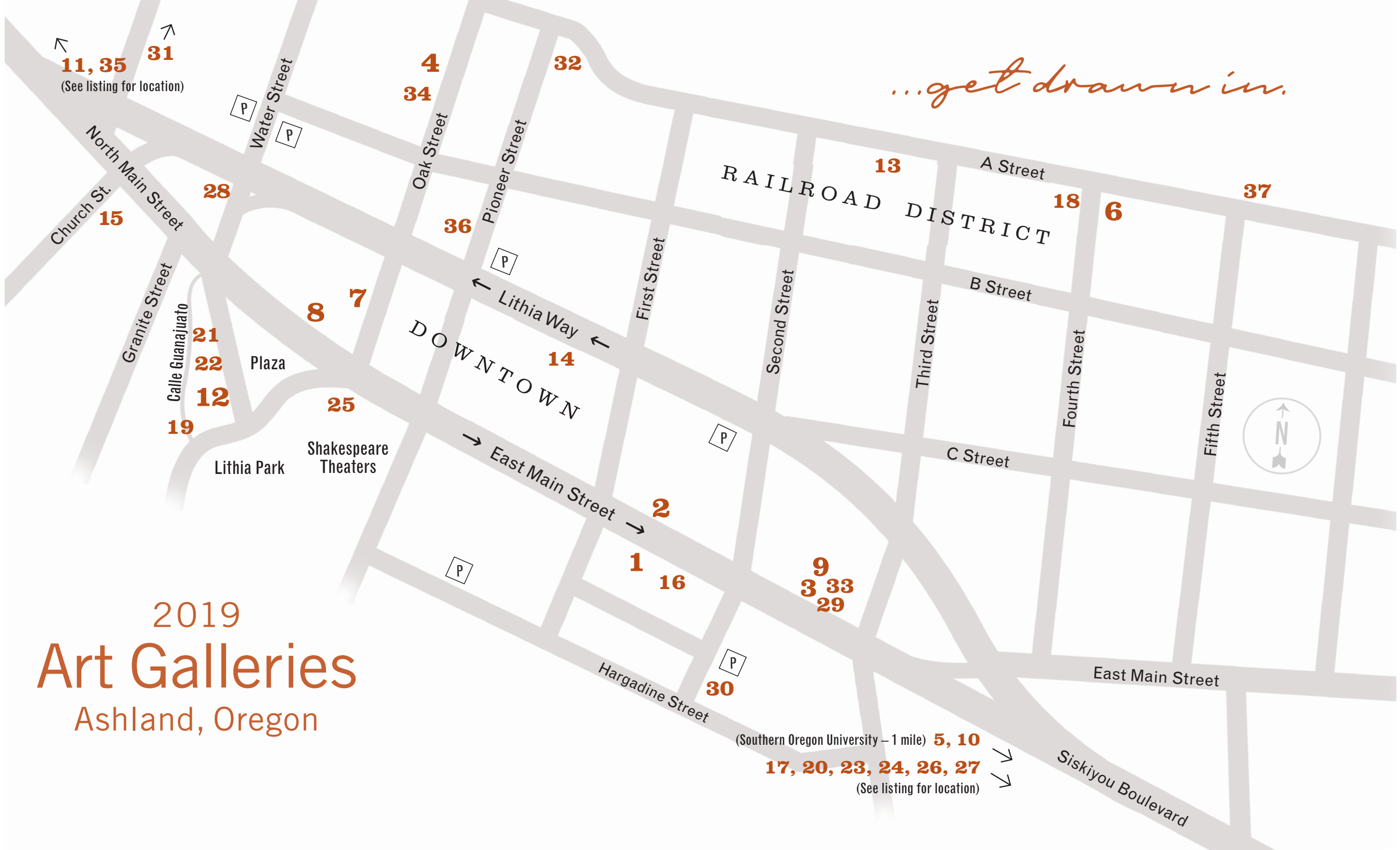
March First Friday features works by budding young student artists from the Ashland High School Art Department.
